METHOD

Design

We integrated qualitative and quantitative methods in the research. In the pilot study, six focus group interviews were conducted with 53 college students enrolled in 6 colleges. In focus groups, a semi-structured interview guide consisted of specific questions asked about factors which that students perceive as influencing their feev fruit and vegetable intake. Data collected in the focus groups guided the selection of variables included as potential correlates of feev fruit and vegetable intake. The focus group interview results and literature wereas used to develop a questionnaire that was used in the following quantitative research.
